1. Pick your favorite book

2. Write your name and grade on a ticket

3. Place that ticket in the box by the book

4. With the supplies provided, create anything that relates to the book

5. The book with the most votes will have its cardboard creation displayed.

6. **The grade level with the most participation will have a special popcorn eating, makerspace creating SIIT time on Friday, October 21.** So be sure to stop in the cafeteria, write your name and grade for a chance to win!

Have a younger child? It's a *family* event, so we will have pumpkin cut-outs to color as well.

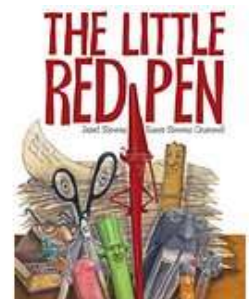
